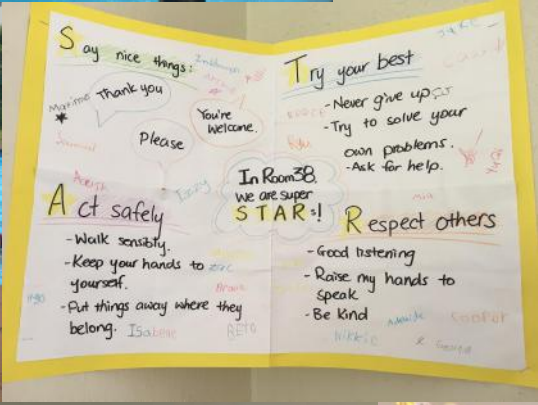


# MEADOWBANK MARVELS 2018

## Reflective Ruru



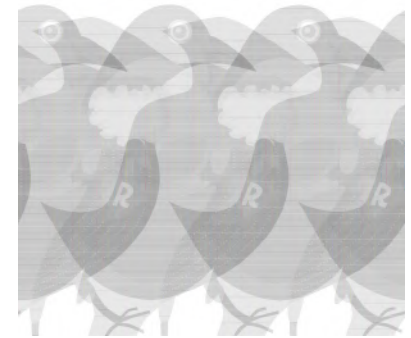
I reflect on my learning, celebrate my successes and identify my next steps.

## Creative Piwakawaka



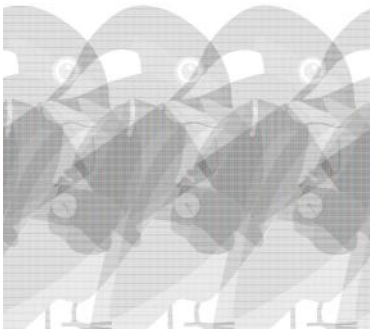
I am a lifelong learner who is curious and a creative problem solver.
